223. USE OF BICYCLES AND MOTOR VEHICLES 1. Purpose The Board regards walking, or the use of bicycles and motor vehicles for travel to and from school by students as an assumption of responsibility by parents and students. The Board shall permit walking and the use of bicycles by students in accordance 2. Authority with district rules, provided that students have been granted permission by the building principal and have obtained parental permission to walk or ride a bicycle to school. The Board shall permit the use of motor vehicles by secondary students in accordance with district rules, provided that such students are licensed drivers, have parental permission when they are minors, and have been granted permission by the building principal to drive a motor vehicle onto school grounds. The Board prohibits the use of mini-bikes, motorized go-carts, motorcycles, nonlicensed motor bikes, snowmobiles, all-terrain vehicles and other recreational vehicles on school property. The Board shall not be responsible for bicycles or motor vehicles of any kind that are lost, stolen, or damaged on school property. 3. Delegation of The Superintendent shall develop rules and regulations for operating and parking bicycles or motor vehicles on school property and shall disseminate those rules to Responsibility affected students.
