NON-DISCRIMINATION NOTICE

In compliance with state and federal law, the Reynolds School District will provide to each protected handicapped student without discrimination or cost to the student or family those related aids, services or accommodations which are needed to provide equal opportunity to participate in and obtain the benefits of the school program and extracurricular activities to the maximum extent appropriate to the student's abilities. In order to qualify as a protected handicapped student, the child must be of school age with a physical or mental disability, which substantially limits or prohibits participation in, or access to, an aspect of the school program.

These services and protections for "protected handicapped students" are distinct from those applicable to all eligible or exceptional students enrolled (or seeking enrollment) in special education programs.

All activities, educational programs, and employment practices of the Reynolds School District are nondiscriminatory as required by school code and various program guidelines. If there are restrictions, they are based on one's ability and aptitude, not on one's sex, race, color, national origin, or handicapping condition. Additionally, handicapped students and employees may qualify for special services or instruction and equipment modifications.
