He also said out of 39 schools in 3 counties (Youngstown Metropolitan Area), Reynolds School District ranked 5th which is highest of the Mercer County. Mr. Sibeto thanked the teachers, administrative, school board, students, and parents for their roles in the achievement of the students.
