

3-D Tissue Reed Sculpture

Objective:

The students will be able to design and construct a three dimensional sculpture using reed as the "skeleton" and covering the framework with tissue paper.

Procedure:

Demonstrate how to use the reed to create the framework or "skeleton" that will support the shape of the sculpture.

After the framework is done, use colorful pieces of tissue paper to cover the sculpture. The sculptures will have a light "floating" feeling about them.

Students are encouraged to develop ideas of their own and get creative with their designs.

The final project can be displayed by hanging from the ceiling with string.

Materials:

Reed- round or flat
Tissue paper
Elmers glue
Hot glue guns and sticks
